Phase I bricks will be placed in front of the remodeled entrance to Hillsdale High School around the base of the bell salvaged from "Central School" tower. Phase 2 will begin adjacent to those bricks and work their way towards the main entrance. We are selling these bricks to raise money for the Hillsdale County Education Foundation Fund, which funds enrichment programs.

The bricks will be laser engraved and the laser engraving will outlast the brick itself.

How are bricks engraved with a laser?

To engrave a brick, a laser is carefully adjusted to melt select parts of the brick's surface. These portions of the brick are converted into a hard black glass that is several times harder than the brick itself. The depth to which this glass surface extends into the brick is a function of the laser's power and how fast its beam moves across the surface. Even with a shallow engraved depth, the mark is permanent because the laser process forms a graded or welded seal between the brick and the glass.

Performance:

The lettering will not fade, erode or chip away. This is in contrast to soft epoxy or paint-filled marks which can become brittle and chip away in a harsh outdoor environment. Unlike traditional sandblasted or stamped brick marks, there are no engraved "valleys" or "canyons" to capture the environmental debris.
